"AWARENESS OF CYBER CRIMES & CYBER LAW"
organized by Government College Gharghoda on 17th January, 2018
Venue: Government College Gharghoda, Seminar Hall

Time - 12:00 PM

Government College Gharghoda and Civil Court, Gharghoda jointly organized a one-day workshop on law enforcement, for Professors and Students. The workshop was held at Seminar Hall, Government College Gharghoda, Dist. Raigarh on 17th January, 2018.

The Resource Persons for the workshop were:

- 1) Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh
- 2) Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam

Workshop aimed at creating awareness on:

- An Overview of Cybercrimes such as Electronic Commerce Crime, Economic Espionage, and Infrastructure attacks
- Types of Cyber-attacks with Case Studies
- Discussion topics: Defamation, Obscenity, Content Accountability, Copyright Violations, Trademark Violations, E commerce and Taxation
- Provisions in the legal framework to combat Cybercrimes
- Discussion on Indian Cyber Law and provision of court proceeding for Cybercrimes.
- Cyber Law from India and International perspective.

HIGHLIGHTS OF WORKSHOP:

At the beginning, Dr. M. L. Patel, Incharge Principal, Government College Gharghoda presented floral welcome to the keynote speakers. A delightful beginning was made by Dr. (Mrs). Shruti Shrivastava with her speech on awareness of Cyber Crimes and Cyber Laws for participants. She emphasized on the need for network etiquettes in our daily life. She talked about the increasing E-frauds & Security issues and shared the internet guidelines which served as a major piece of information for everyone attending the workshop. Honourable Principal, Govt. College Gharghoda, Dr. M. L. Patel addressed the participants with his inspiring words that, Govt. College Gharghoda and Civil Court, Gharghoda together attempt to develop a spirit of collaboration, competition, and team- building through a series of unmatched events and activities. This workshop was the step forward in the same direction. He laid emphasis on the hacker's activities over the network & internet. He made brief remarks about the importance of study of Cyber Crimes and Cyber Law today. Then he invited two keynote Speakers Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh and Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam to start the session. Both the keynote speakers presented their thoughts and made participants aware about basics of Cybercrimes, Cyber-attacks and provision of Laws with Case Studies.

TECHNICAL SESSIONS FROM KEYNOTE SPEAKERS:

TECHNICAL SESSION - I

The first Technical Session was started by Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh. She shared her experience and raised awareness of the importance of cybercrime and cyber security policies and strategies. She made participants aware about myths of Cyber laws with simple examples. She explained Defamation, Obscenity, Content Accountability, Copyright Violations, Trademark Violations, E-commerce and Taxation with Case Studies. She highlighted the risks and exposures that all organization's face with regard to unauthorized intrusions and theft on the business systems. She made the participants aware about the impact of cybercrime. She covered intellectual property theft, corporate espionage, legal considerations, risks and mitigation strategies with provisions in the legal framework to combat Cybercrimes.

TECHNICAL SESSION - II

The second Technical Session was by Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam. She started with simple definition of Cyber-crime. She introduced Law, copyright Laws, Cyber Law from India and International Perspective. She talked about IT ACT. She explained participants about E-records vulnerability and authentication of E-records with some case studies. Her session included cyber crime offences like accessing electronic systems for dishonest purpose, Illegal system interference, Attempts or Produces, sells, procures for use, imports, distributes or makes available Illegal devices, Making, selling, distributing or possessing software for committing a crime, Identity Fraud - that is using of another person's identity to commit a crime electronically, Forgery of electronic data, the illegal use of unwanted multiple electronic messages with intent to deceive or mislead users of an electronic system, Solicitation of children, Child Pornography, Harassment utilizing means of electronic communication, Offences related to using mobile phones to text or send indecent video clips or private video clips etc. She shared her knowledge & experience on "How to be safe with Social Media". She discussed some cases related to social media impacts and also provision of court proceeding for Cybercrimes.

OUTCOME:

Workshop such as this provides a great opportunity for diverse range of groups to interact and discuss the dealing with Cybercrime.

The Workshop was concluded with presenting vote of thanks to the keynote speakers.

OBJECTIVE OF THE WORKSHOP

The workshop was held at Seminar Hall, Government College Gharghoda, Dist. Raigarh on 28th January, 2019.

Under the guidance of Additional District Judge, Ashish Pathak, a legal awareness workshop was organized by Government College Gharghoda, Dist. Raigarh. The theme entitled “**Child Labour, Child Abuse, Rights of women and their protection from Domestic Violence**”.

OBJECTIVE of THE WORKSHOP:

The main objective of the programme was to make the students aware about child rights, child abuse and various issues related to women and steps provided in law for overcoming the same. The main reason for conducting such programs is that Legal education helps in changing the attitude of public and make them connect to the social problems; it makes people more aware about their rights and duties and help them to become ideal citizens.

IQAC Coordinator Ms. Renu Kujur, formally welcomed all the dignitaries present on the dais and participants. She mentioned about the importance of awareness activities in order to make people aware of their rights and about the role, activities and functioning of the legal services. She then invited the eminent speakers Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh and Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam to lead the session.

TECHNICAL SESSIONS FROM KEYNOTE SPEAKERS:

TECHNICAL SESSION – I

- The first Technical Session was taken by Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam. She started with simple definition of child labour and child abuse. Child labour has been the most important concern in the world because it affects the children both mentally and physically. It also destroys their future.
- She spoke about child abuse which is a ubiquitous problem with personal, interpersonal, and social consequences. Risk factors are well established, and preventive strategies have been effective in decreasing abusive parenting behaviours and child maltreatment incident reports.

- She delivered lectures about Child rights and protection of children from sexual offence. She also highlighted various schemes being launched by the Govt. for the benefit of Child and women rights.

TECHNICAL SESSION - II

- The Second Technical Session was taken by Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh. She told that according to available statistics from around the globe, one out of every three women has experienced violence in an intimate relationship at some point in her life. There are several Act that provide effective protection of the rights of women guaranteed under the Constitution who are victims of violence of any kind occurring within the family and formatters connected therewith or incidental thereto.
- One main concern in tribal area is "Macabre practice of Witch-hunting" - Witch-hunting is essentially a legacy of violence against women in our society. For almost invariably, it is women, especially Dalit or Adivasi widow women, who are branded as Dayan's or Witches by relatives, villagers who have an eye over their houses or land. Nearly 200 to 150 women are killed every year in India after being tagged as 'witches'. There are several rights and protection from this offence.

Dr. Y. K. Chandra delivered vote of thanks and requested the organizers to hold more such enlightening programs in near future.

Preamble: One-day Awareness Program on "HUMAN RIGHTS" has been conducted on 10 December 2019, at Government College Gharghoda in order to spread human rights literacy among the participants. The workshop has been jointly organized by Civil Court, Gharghoda and Government College, Gharghoda.

Objective of the Awareness program: Human rights education promotes values, beliefs and attitudes that encourage all individuals to uphold their own rights and those of others. It develops an understanding of everyone's common responsibility to make human rights a reality in each community.

Description about the Program:

- Dr. Shruti Shrivastava, Asst. Prof., English, formally welcomed all the dignitaries present on the dais and participants. She mentioned about the importance of awareness activities in order to make people aware of their rights and about the role, activities and functioning of the legal services. She then invited the eminent speakers Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh and Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam to lead the session

TECHNICAL SESSION – I

- The first Technical Session was taken by Judicial Magistrate Ku. Pratibha Markam. She told that the United Nations Declaration on the Rights of Indigenous People (UNDRIP), was adopted in 2007, for which India voted, recognises among other things indigenous peoples' rights to self-determination, autonomy or self-governance, and their right against forcible displacement and relocation from their lands or territories without free, prior and informed consent. Indigenous and Tribal Peoples, 1989 which is based on the "respect for the cultures and ways of life of indigenous peoples" and recognises their "right to land and natural resources and to define their own priorities for development." India is not a party to this, but it is a party to the ILO Convention concerning the Protection and Integration of Indigenous and Other Tribal and Semi-Tribal Populations in Independent Countries, 1957 which is outdated and closed for ratification.

TECHNICAL SESSION - II

- The Second Session was taken by Judicial Magistrate Smt. Shivani Singh. She spoke on the topic: "Know your rights". She emphasized on the atrocities enacted upon the tribal and elaborated the role of the National Human Rights Commission in helping and protecting them. She also told the rights for all the tribal in Indian Constitution.

Rights for Tribal in Indian Constitution regarding

- Promotion of Social, Economic and Educational Interests
- Safeguard of Tribal Interests
- Human Trafficking
- Cultural and Educational Rights

The entire session was an interactive session and the speakers answered many queries raised by the participants. IQAC Coordinator, Ms. Renu Kujur proposed vote of thanks. The entire programme was co-ordinated with the support of the Principal and faculty of Government College Gharghoda.
